#### NOTICE OF RACE



## 505 French Championship 2022

Yacht Club de l'Odet (Bénodet)

From 13 to 17 July 2022 -

#### Grade 3 (Under the aegis of the French Sailing Federation

The notation [NP] in a *rule* means that a boat cannot protest (No protest) against another boat when infringing this *rule*. This changes RRS 60.1(a). Mention [NP] at the beginning of each rule to which it applies. The notation [DP] in a rule means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification. Mention [DP] at the beginning of each rule to which it applies.

#### 1. RULES

The Regatta is governed by:

- 1) The rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing,
- 2) National prescriptions, translated for non-French speaking competitors, in joined appendix named "prescriptions".
- 3) FFVoile regulations
- 4) Class 5o5 rules in effect.
- 5) When this notice of race is translated, the French text will take precedence.
- 6) Prevention against Covid 19: Prevention and hygiene measures will apply.

### 2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SIS)

- 1) The Sailing Instructions will be available on Thursday July 14, 2022 from 9:00 a.m. at the club house of the Yacht Club de l'Odet.
- 2) The sailing instructions will be posted according to federal prescription.
- 3) Sailing instructions will be available on the website http://www.yco-voile.fr

#### 3. COMMUNICATION

- 1) The online notice board can be found on Coq beach (next to the old ferry hold).
- 2) [DP] Except in an emergency, a boat while racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

### 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 1) The event is open to boats of the 5o5 class.
- 2) Documents eligible for registration:
  - a) For each competitor with a FFVoile Club licence
    - the valid FFVoile club licence with "Competition" mention,
    - the valid FFVoile club licence with "Adhesion" or "Pratique" mention, accompanied with
      - for minors, a testimonial of completion of a questionnaire related to the health condition of the minor competitor
      - o for adults, a medical certificate dated less than one year, mentioning the absence of any medical objection to participate in sailing competition
  - b) For each competitor without a FFVoile Club licence, whether foreign or French national living abroad shall present during registration:
    - a supporting document to justify membership to a World Sailing Member national authority.
- a supporting document to justify a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 2 million Euros.
- for minors, a testimonial of completion of a questionnaire related to the health condition of the minor competitor or, for adults, a medical certificate dated less than one year, mentioning the absence of any medical objection to participate in sailing competition

- c) For the boat the measurement form or rating certificate of the boat,
- 3) Eligible boats can register by completing the online form on the www.yco-voile.fr website and paying the required registration fees online or by bank transfer, before July 1, 2021 to the Yacht Club de I 'Odet. Sailing instructions, pennants, etc., will be given to registrants with a complete file. To be considered entered in the event, a boat must meet all entry requirements and pay all fees.

#### 5. ENTRY FEES

- The fees required are €125.00 including tax per boat. A 50% discount is expected for crews under 25 years of age.
- 2) The crew dinner requires an additional €25.00 including tax per person.
- 3) In the event of withdrawal after July 6, 2022, a lump sum of €50.00 will be retained.
- 4) Registrations will be fully refunded if the event is cancelled due to the Covid 19 pandemic, following a decision by the French government.

#### 6. ADVERTISING

- 1) [DP] Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 2) Competitor advertising will be restricted as follows: no marking, logotype, design or distinctive sign, intended to refer to a company or organization, will be authorized on any part of the yachts.

#### 7 QUALIFICATIONS AND FINAL SERIES

Not applicable.

#### 8 SCHEDULE

This program is likely to be modified according to the evolution of the French health situation.

2) Three races per day at maximum.

3) The July 14, 2022, the last race of day will be a coastal course.

4) On last racing day scheduled (Sunday July 17, 2022), no warning signal will be made after 3:00 p.m.











#### **EQUIPMENTS CONTROL**

- 1) Each boat shall show a proof of the existence of a rating valid certificate
- 2) Boats may be controlled at any time.
- 3) Following equipment shall be controlled or measured: Safety equipment, sails, rigging, hull, appendages
- 4) [DP] Boats shall also comply with RRS 78.1 when they present themselves for control

#### 10 CLOTHES AND EQUIPMENT

Clothes and equipment of competitors shall not weigh more than 10 kilograms, excluding abseiling or trapeze belts and clothing (including footwear) worn below the knee. For everything else, the provisions of RRS 43 apply.

#### 11 VENUE

The event will be run in a race area located between the Pointe de Loctudy and the Pointe de Mousterlin. Refer to the attached appendix.

#### 12. THE COURSES

The courses will be of the constructed type (Banana) or coastal. Hare departures are envisaged.

#### 13. PENALTY SYSTEM

For the class 505 RRS 44.1 has been changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

#### 14. RANKING

The ranking system is as follows

- 1) The ranking system will be the minimum points system.
- 2) Three races must be validated to validate the competition.
- 3) A boat's score in a series shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score:
- When less than 4 races have been completed, a boat's score in a series will be the total scores of his races.
- When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's score in a series will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

#### 15. SUPPORT BOATS

Accompanying boats and any support boats must be registered with the Organizing Authority at the entry confirmation times specified in 8.1 and must declare to what extent they are associated. They must be identified by the handlebars of the YCO.

#### 16. BOATS CHARTERED OR LOANED

A boat chartered or loaned can carry national letters or a sail number not complying with her class rules, if the race committee previously approved her identification, before the first race.

#### 17. BERTHING

Boats will be taken out of water at the Coq beach in Bénodet (next to the old ferry hold).

#### 18 DATA PROTECTION

- 1) Image and appearance rights: Participating in the competition, the competitor and his legal representative authorize the OA, the FFVoile and their sponsors to use free of charge his image and his name, to show at any time (during and after the competition) static or moving pictures, films or TV recording, as well as other reproduction from himself done during the competition, and this on any support and for any use related to the promotion of their activities.
- 2) Use of personal data of participants: Participating in this competition, the competitor and his legal representatives agree to and authorize the FFVoile, its sponsors, as well as the OA to use and store, free of charge, his personal data. These data may be published by FFVoile and its sponsors. The FFVoile mainly, but also its sponsors may use these data for the development of softwares or with marketing purposes. In accordance with the « Règlement Général sur la Protection des Données (RGPD) » (General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)), any competitor having transmitted his personal data to the FFVoile, may exercise have them modified, and, depending on the situations, have them deleted, limited, or to object them, sending an email to <a href="mailto:dpo@ffvoile.fr">dpo@ffvoile.fr</a> or a letter to the Head Office of the Fédération Française de Voile, mentioning that the request is related to personal data.

#### **RECOGNITION OF RISKS**

RRS 3 mentions: « The responsibility for a boat decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone. » Participating in this event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges the fact that sailing is potentially a dangerous activity with specific risks. These risks include strong winds and rough sea, sudden changes of weather conditions, failure of equipment, mistakes in boat handling, bad navigation of other boats, loss of balance on unstable surface, and causing increased risk of injury. The risk of material and/or physical damage is therefore inherent in the sport of sailing.

#### 20. **PRIZES**

Prizes will be distributed to the first three. The first in the general classification will be crowned "Champion of France 5o5". Additional prices are provided for young crews (-25 years old), mixed, lady.

### **APPENDIX COVID 19 UPDATED TO MARCH 14, 2022**

Preamble: Depending on the evolution of the health crisis, the Organizing Authority may modify the conditions of the notice of race without notice. The Yacht Club de l'Odet website (www.yco-voile.fr) will be used as the "Official Board". There will be no physical display. Competitors must provide themselves with a means allowing them to receive these communications. This cannot be the subject of a claim for compensation. This modifies RRS 62.1(a). Depending on the evolution of the health crisis, the Organizing Authority may modify the conditions of registration and/or eligibility. In the unprecedented "COVID 19" context, the Organizing Authority may cancel the competition.

#### 1 Barrier gestures (DP):

Before confirming their registration, each crew member must have individually completed the self-health questionnaire available at the following address:

All participants in the French 5o5 Championship, whether they are organizers, referees, runners, or accompanying persons, must be in possession of masks and a bottle of individual hydro-alcoholic gel, from arrival to departure from the site of the competition, on land and on the water.

Groups of people must be organized in compliance with government recommendations and barrier gestures. Wearing a mask is recommended when barrier gestures cannot be respected. Barrier gestures must be respected by all. Failure to comply with the instructions issued or transmitted by the organizer, including orally, may lead to a complaint on the initiative of the Jury.

Reasonable actions by the competition authority to implement COVID-19 guidelines, protocols or legislation, even if later found to be unnecessary, are not improper actions or omissions and will not result in upon request for repair (this modifies RRS 62.1(a)).

- 1) COVID referent and crisis unit in the event of suspected contagion:

- 2) COVID cell in case of suspected contagion
  - Representative of the Odet Yacht Club Yves Monmoton.
  - Race Committee Presidents Patrick Quideau.
  - The President of the Jury Patrick Vilain.

#### 3) Operation:

This unit will follow the recommendations issued by the Ministry of Sports in the document "Health protocol management of cases of suspicion and positive Covid-19 cases / sports movement":

This cell must be informed of any suspicion of COVID before, during and after the competition. This cell will deal with any COVID suspicions and decide what action to take in such a case. Any cell decision COVID is final and must be respected, in accordance with this appendix and the articles of the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions that deal with the COVID 19 health crisis.

#### 3.1 Consideration of the Covid19 Risk by the participants:

By registering for the French 5o5 Championship, all competitors certify that they are aware of the Covid-19 risk, as well as than his companions, and to have taken this into account.

Each competitor and accompanying person is therefore fully aware of:

- Hygiene and physical distancing measures, known as "barrier gestures" to be observed everywhere and at at any time, as well as additional provisions published by the Ministry of Sports, and undertakes to respect them.
- The risk of contamination accentuated by the proximity of another person, especially when sailing on a crewed or double sailboat, or any other situation of proximity of less than one meter, without the adequate reinforced protections.
- That despite the implementation of reinforced means of protection, the practice can expose to a risk health, in particular contamination by Covid-19.
- That despite the arrangements made and the means committed, the host establishment, Le Yacht Club de Odet, cannot guarantee total protection against exposure and contamination with Covid 19. It releases the Organizing Authority from any liability in the event of contamination.
- That all these measures aim to preserve the health and physical abilities of the competitors, accompanying persons and members of the Organizing Authority participating in the regatta.

· In the event of a positive Covid test, any participant must withdraw from the competition. Anyone who is declared as a contact case must be tested in accordance with the protocol in force.

#### 3.2 Suspected case of COVID 19:

A competitor, who presents symptoms related to Covid 19, must be tested as soon as possible. If this test is positive for COVID19, he must immediately abandon the race / competition and comply with the directives health authorities. ## APPENDIX "NATIONAL PRESCRIPTIONS" FFVoile Prescriptions to RRS 2021-2024 translated for non-francophone competitors

FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 25.1** (*Notice of race, sailing instructions and signals*):

For events graded 4 and 5, standard notices of race and sailing instructions including the specificities of the event shall be used. Events graded 4 may have dispensation for such requirement, after receipt of FFVoile approval, received before the notice of race has been published.

For events graded 5, posting of sailing instructions will be considered as meeting the requirements of RRS 25.1 application.

(\*) FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 64.4** (Decisions on protests concerning class rules):

The protest committee may ask the parties to the protest, prior to checking procedures, a deposit covering the cost of checking arising from a protest concerning class rules.

(\*) FFVoile Prescription to RRS 67 (Damages):

Any question or request related to damages arising from an incident occurred while a boat was bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing depends on the appropriate courts and cannot be examined and dealt by a protest committee.

A boat that retires from a race or accepts a penalty does not, by that such action, admit liability for damages.

(\*) FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 70. 5** (Appeals and requests to a national authority):

The denial of the right of appeal is subject to the written approval of the Fédération Française de Voile, received before publishing the notice of race. This approval shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.

(\*) FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 76.1** (Exclusion of boats or competitors)

An organizing authority or race committee shall not reject or cancel the entry of a boat or exclude a competitor eligible under the notice of race and sailing instructions for an arbitrary reason.

(\*) FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 78.1** (Compliance with class rules; certificates):

The boat's owner or other person in charge shall, under his sole responsibility, make sure moreover that his boat complies with the equipment and security rules required by the laws, by-laws and regulations of the Administration.

(\*) FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 86.3** (Changes to the racing rules):

An organizing authority wishing to change a rule listed in RRS 86.1(a) in order to develop or test new rules shall first submit the changes to the FFVoile, in order to obtain its written approval and shall report the results to FFVoile after the event. Such approval shall be mentioned in the notice of race and in the sailing instructions and shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.

(\*) FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 88.2** (Changes to prescriptions):

Prescriptions of the FFVoile shall not be changed in the notice of race and sailing instructions, except for events for which an international jury has been appointed.

In such case, the prescriptions marked with an asterisk (\*) shall not be changed in the notice of race and sailing instructions. (The official translation of the prescriptions, downloadable on the FFVoile website www.ffvoile.fr, shall be the only translation used to comply with RRS 90.2(b)).

(\*) FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 91(b)** (*Protest committee*):

The appointment of an international jury meeting the requirements of Appendix N is subject to prior written approval of the Fédération Française de Voile. Such approval shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.
